#### **FAMILY OF FAITH UPDATE**

In December 2017 we received our parish distribution from the Family of Faith program. Our parish share was \$15,644.99. As per Archdiocesan policy 50% is automatically used to pay down our parish debts and the other 50% is held in an investment account at the Diocese. Therefore our 50% (7.822.50) for debt was applied by the Archdiocese to our two existing loans as follows:

#### Capital campaign loan \$3,911.25 Chancery Loan \$3,911.25

(parish share of family of faith campaign costs).

Thank you to those who are keeping up their pledges to the Family of Faith and we encourage those that have not been able to do so to please begin your pledges when you can.

#### ONE MORE YEAR OF OUR LOAN INTEREST FREE PERIOD

We had been granted two years (2017/2018) of interest free for our outstanding Capital campaign loan. During the first year, we saved \$12,655.31 in interest and the payments were applied directly to the loan balance. We now have one more year to take advantage of this. PLEASE review your finances and if you are able to make a contribution to our debt in 2018 it will greatly benefit the parish in its effort to pay off this outstanding debt. It is in our best interest to pay down the loan as quickly as possible before we once again face interest charges on the remaining balance a year from now.

Thanks to your donations, fundraising events, family of faith campaign and interest free period, we were able to pay off **\$100,911.25** during the year 2017 and with your help we are hoping to accomplish this or more again during 2018. Donations may be made each month using the gold colored envelope in your box, or by using the envelopes provided on the bookcases. PAG (monthly automatic bank withdrawals) are also set-up through the office. If you prefer to make a one-time donation please do so. All donations are much appreciated. Please refer to the chart on the back wall to keep progress of where we are at with the loan balance.


