## What is World Water Day?

Sustainable Development Goal 6 is crystal clear: water for all by 2030. This means leaving no one behind. But today, billions of people are still living without safe water – their households, schools, workplaces, farms and factories struggling to survive and thrive.

Marginalized groups – women, children, refugees, indigenous peoples, disabled people and many others – are often overlooked, and sometimes face discrimination, as they try to access and manage the safe water they need.

This World Water Day, 22nd March, is about tackling the water crisis by addressing the reasons why so many people are being left behind.



In preparation for World Water Day March 22, 2019

the CWL asks you to consider the following:

- . Turn off the tap while brushing your teeth
- . Turn off the tap while you scrub your hands
- · Operate dishwasher and washer only when full
- · Fix a leaky faucet
- . Shorten the number of minutes for each shower
- . Fill a pitcher with water and store in fridge so do not run water to cool
- . Do not let the water run continuously to rinse dishes
- If washing dishes, put water in the sink rather than letting the tap run while washing
- Use biodegradable dish soap and then use dishwater for watering plants after competing dishwashing
- · Collect rain water and/or melt snow to water plants
