At the age of 26 he joined the Society of St. Vincent de Paul and afterwards, with a group of Catholic women and Father Michael Tober he founded the first family of what was to become the first Praesidium of the Legion of Mary on Sept. 7th 1921. From that day until his death Nov. 7th, 1980 he guided the worldwide extension of the Legion of Mary.
