Resurrection through forgiveness.

Jesus always teaches us to love life by forgiving others; to reach for the highest good, practice sacrificial love and speak the truth. No one was actually present to witness the resurrection, people only saw the empty tomb. The linen wrappings were neatly folded on the side inside Jesus' empty tomb. This parallels the event in Genesis when Abraham is building the altar on Mount Moriah on which to sacrifice his son Isaac. Abraham arranges the wood of the altar in order. By Abraham's attempted sacrifice, it starts the process of salvation history to restore humanity into order.

We take part in Jesus' death and resurrection process through our Baptism and also our renewal of Baptismal promises.
