FINANCIAL UPDATE

We have recently incurred some large expenses to the Parish.

The two older furnaces in the parish hall basement finally quit working.

The cost to replace both of these amounted to \$27,400.00

A new telephone system and office door security system was installed \$3,000.00

We were able to access the remaining \$24,000.00 the Archdiocese held in our Family of Faith Account to help cover some of the costs of these expenses. Approval for the use of the funds was given by our regional Bishop Nguyen as it followed the potential use category in our Mission Statement.

We have paid off all loans to the Archdiocese.

Please continue to donate in the gold colored monthly envelope in your box of parish envelopes (you will notice it has been renamed to RENOVATION PROJECTS beginning 2023) to help us save for future large repairs to the parish property. It is very important we plan ahead for these expenses. Thanks for your continued support.
