

It has become key part of my own spiritual life: when I'm home, I begin every day going to my chapel and spending an hour in prayer. And while the Holy Hour often requires sacrifice, the spiritual fruits are bountiful-most especially in cultivating your personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

In **The Holy Hour: Meditations for Eucharistic Adoration**, you will find a collection of hymns, poetry, prayers, reflections, and some of my own writing to accompany you through your Holy Hour.
