Italy publicly scolds Macron over Ukraine

intervention talk. The French president had previously laid out conditions for sending Western troops to aid Kiev. Emmanuel Macron's statements about the possibility of sending Western forces into Ukraine have only escalated tensions and do not serve any other purpose, Italian Defense Minister Guido Crosetto said on Saturday.

His comments come after the French President stated in an interview with The Economist this week that his country could consider sending its troops to help Kiev "if the Rusians were to break through the front lines" and if there was a "Ukrainian request" for such assistance. Macron also outlined his "strategic objective" of making sure Russia does not win in Ukraine, claiming such a development would threaten European security.
