#### NATO "Preparing for war' with Russia - Orban

Hungarian Prime Minister Viktor Orban said on Friday that there are "*alarming similarities*" between the emotionally charged media publications and statements by Western politicians regarding the Ukraine conflict and the atmosphere preceding the First and Second World Wars. "*What is happening today in Brussels and Washington...looks like warming up for a possible direct military conflict. We can safely call it the preparation of Europe's entry into the war.*"

He warned that the end result of these actions could be a direct conflict between the EU, NATO and Russia - a "grim prospect." as the conflict would involve nuclear powers.

Commenting on Western claims that Russia could attack Europe if it defeats Ukraine, Orban said the chances of this happening are extremely slim, and these warnings only serve as an excuse to become directly involved in the Ukraine conflict. May 24, 2024

# Let Ukraine strike Russia with Some Western Arms

NATO Secretary-General Jens Stoltenberg has argued in an interview with The Economist, that "The time has come for allies to consider whether they should lift some of the restrictions they have put on the use of weapons they have donated to Ukraine,", adding that under the current circumstances that "to deny Ukraine the possibility of using these weapons against legitimate military targets on Russian territory makes it very hard for them to defend themselves." Stoltenberg noted that some NATO members have already lifted restrictions on using their weapons to attack targets in Russian territory. Stoltenberg said that "We provide training, we provide weapons, ammunition to Ukraine, but we will not be directly involved FROM NATO territory in combat operations over or in Ukraine," he said, "So, that's a different thing", hopefully managing to tread the Geopolitical needle, We Pray to God! # Italian Prime Minister Accuses NATO of Escalation Tensions with Moscow

Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni accused NATO Secretary-General Jens Stoltenberg of escalating tensions with Moscow saying, "I don't know why Stoltenberg said such a thing, I think we have to be very careful," Meloni told Italy's Rai 3 TV channel on Sunday. "There are many questionable statements," Meloni added, recalling how she rebuked French President Emmanuel Macron over his remarks on potentially sending troops to Ukraine. Deputy Prime Minister Matteo Salvini told an election rally on Sunday that, "NATO cannot force us to kill in Russia, nor can anyone force us to send Italian soldiers to fight or die in Ukraine," arguing that Rome is sending Kiev weapons only to "defend itself," not to "fight, strike and kill outside its territory." "This gentleman, (Stoltenberg-NATO Secretary General) should either ask for forgiveness, rectify his remarks or resign," Salvini added. May 26, 2024
