THE SIX DAILY HABITS

For spiritual resiliency

1. The Morning Offering:

The best way to start the day is to give it over to God and his powerful blessing:

2. Pray with Scripture:

Take 10-15 minutes (or more) each day to sit quietly with God's word. Read, ponder, then talk to Jesus. What strikes your heart? Allow it to fill you.

3. Spiritual Reading:

Want to be holy? At some point in your day, spend 5-10 minutes reading a spiritual book that interests you. For a list of recommended titles, see the full eBook.

4. The Good Turn:

Charity is like a muscle that needs to be exercised. Decide to perform one deliberate good deed (about and beyond the usual) for someone each day. "Love shows itself more in actions than in words." – St. Ignatius of Loyola

5. Something Beautiful:

We need to nourish our souls with the true beauty that has its origin in God. Take a daily nature walk or enjoy the discovery of fine art, music, novels or new hobbies.

6. The Evening Examen:

At the end of each day, the martyrs would take 5-10 minutes and look back, identifying where the graces were and where the growth opportunities were. Here's the Examen in three simple steps:

- First, put yourself in God's presence and breathe deeply. Ask for the grace to see what you are looking for. Consider the key blessings of the day and give thanks.
- **Second**, consider the moments when you did not live up to the grace you were given. Consider why, ask pardon of the Lord, and resolve to do better.
- **Third**, request whatever grace you need for making tomorrow live up to your new expectations. End with an Our Father.

Create your own spiritual life plan. It could look like this:

Daily: the six habits listed above

Weekly: Mass

• Monthly: confession
