#### **EMERGENCY LENTEN APPEAL**

Dr. Andrew Simone, on behalf of Canadian Food for Children is asking our Parish for contributions of Iodized salt, canned meat, canned fish and soap bars to ship 40-foot containers with our "gifts of love" to Africa, the Caribbean and South America. #### **Communion to the Sick on Sunday - New Process**

For those parishioners who are well-known and have permission to bring Communion to the sick after Sunday masses, beginning the First Sunday in April, please place your Pyx on the tray either on the Sacristy wooden counter or the table in the Sanctuary beside where the Lectors sit.

At the end of Mass, after the distribution of communion to the people the Extraordinary Eucharistic Ministers will be called up to collect their pyxes from the Priest or Deacon from whom they shall receive a blessing. The person or persons will immediately leave the Church carrying Jesus to the sick and are expected to go directly to that person, avoiding all socializing and not holding the Most Blessed Eucharist to be given to the sick person at some later time that day. 
